Know all men by these presents that I Smith Bradley of Greenville District in the aforesaid State in consideration of five dollars to me paid by Jane Bradley and Isaac Coleman and his wife Florida have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Jane Bradley and Isaac Coleman and his wife Florida all my right interest and title either in Law or Equity in a certain piece parcel or tract of Land lying or being in Greenville District on the water of Enoree being the same tract that was jointly owned by Thomas Bradley and Curtis Bradley and in which the said Thomas Bradley conveyed his interest to Curtis Bradley and in which I had an Equitable interest adjoining lands of J. Perkins Gilcath and others

Together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereto in any wise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jane Bradley Isaac Coleman and Florida his wife their heirs and assigns forever Given and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jane Bradley Isaac Coleman and Florida his wife their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and no further lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
