To all to whom these presents shall come I William A McDaniel Sheriff of

Guenville District my State aforesaid send greeting Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Guenville to wit the fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one at the suit of Henry Godd to me to wit directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of Daniel Harrison to levy the sum of One hundred and thirteen dollars being damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Daniel Harrison all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land containing One hundred and thirty four acres Situate and being in the District of Guenville on Vaughan Creek branch waters of Packett Place adjoining lands of Mrs Martha Fisher Green Mills & and others being the same tract whereon Daniel Harrison now resides

And whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the said writ made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned have been offered to sale at public vendue and purchased by Benjamin J. Perry of the District of Guenville for the sum of Two hundred and eighty dollars being the highest sum that was bid thereon

Now know ye that I William A McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid have directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of Two hundred and eighty dollars to me in hand paid and now to be paid by the said Benjamin J. Perry the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin J. Perry this tract and appurtenances of the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Daniel Harrison of right had of in and to the same

To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of Land with its appurtenances unto the said Benjamin J. Perry his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said William A McDaniel might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of fieri facias or otherwise
