I know all men by their names and presents that Edward Hill of the State into District of Georgia for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten only five dollars to me in hand paid by James Henson of the same State and District the receipt and payment are truly acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the State and District on wild cat branch of Tullimberg Creek waters of middle Tigeo River into the said James Henson and during his natural life for the use of Elijah Henson his son and his heirs and at the death of the said James Henson beginning on a Red Oak on Paches Mountain the corner of the Clayton Grant thence nearly South with the line of the Grant to the branch on Milton Powder line thence down the branch as it meanders for ever so by running in a North direction to Sheriff's line to make fifty acres ^{three fourths} together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances belonging to the same or in anywise incident or appertaining to it of the said Edward Hill doth for myself my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said James Henson and at his death to his son Elijah Henson his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns for and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof I the said Edward Hill hath set my hand and seal this 23rd day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one.
