State of South Carolina, known all men by
Grenville District. I, the subscriber, Robert Blakely of the State and his wife above
named, for the consideration of Fifteen Hun-
dred dollars to me in hand paid by Wm B.

Jones of the same place I have bargained sold and released and by these presents do
grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Wm B. Jones his heirs and af-
fess the plantation or tract of land wherein I now live containing 197 acres more or
less Beginning at a Poplar Stump 34 ft high S 37° W 147° R. 3 S 32° E. 7 ft a
Rock & N 44° E. N. 14. 16 D. 17 d. 18 A. 84. E 34° 45' to a rock 34 ft N 44° W 16 D. 16
34 m. & N 14° 45' to a rock & S 88° W 15 to a Rock 34 ft S 48° E. 10 to a Rock
34 ft N 12° 45' 12 to a branch in all 32 ft a Rock 34 ft S 28° W 13 1/2 ft to a Rock 34 ft S
44° E. 6. 45' to the beginning corner Originally Granted to Peter Paquette of 500
acres dated the 11th day of May 1773 with all and singular the rights, members, heredit-
amers & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold in peaceful possession forever and the said
Robert Blakely do hereby bind myself my heirs executors, Wm B. Jones to warrant &
forever defend the said plantation of 197 acres unto the said Wm B. Jones his heirs
and assigns to him and to his in his own right and title against myself
and assigns forever with all the profits thereof belonging against any person
a person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

whomsoever, renounce release and forever relinquish unto the said Wm B.
Jones his heirs and assigns all her right title interest and estate on
also all her right and claim of slaves of in or to all & singular the prop-
erty within mentioned and released.
