sum of Thirty Three dollars you to me in full partly William S. Howard  
of the State and District above named have granted the aforesaid bill of sale  
unto the said William S. Howard all that tract of land containing  
Fifteen acres to the same more or less being a piece of vacant land that was  
granted to me by a grant bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1834 and lying  
on a small branch waters of the South Fork of Tyger River and is  
bounded as follows beginning at a Stake 33<sup>rd</sup> S. 18.75 chains to a Stake  
at in place of Charles 3<sup>rd</sup> gone there about 16.50 to a Stake on Jonathan Turners  
line thence N 45<sup>o</sup> E with Turners line to the beginning and bounded  
on the N W by J. Hammills Land S. E by the above named Amy Southerton  
and S. E by Jonathan Turners Land.

Together with all and singular the rights members appurtenances and appendments to the same belonging or in anywise incident  
appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid premises unto  
William S. Howard his heirs and assigns forever and I do fully my self my  
heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the aforesaid premises unto the aforesaid William Howard his heirs and assigns forever against  
myself myself and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming  
to claim the same or any part thereof. The witness whereof I have caused to be  
signed and sealed this the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November one thousand eight hundred  
and fifty five and in the eighth year of the Independence of the United  
States of America.
