 person or persons whomsoever whom she release and forever relinquish
 unto William Barton his heirs and assigns all her interest and estate
 and also her right and claim of dower of in or to all and singular
 the premises hereafter described and released by her said husband Joseph
 Barton supposing to contain sixty one acres more or less To wit a certain
 tract from a parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville District
 in said State on the middle fork of Tyger River the being part of a tract
 of land granted to Maj John Gowan and by him bequeathed to his son
 Wm B Gowan and by him conveyed to Jonathan Stokes and by him
 to Saml West and by him to Blair Maltliver and from him to Joseph
 and William Barton and by them divided by relinquishments bearing date
 the fourth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and forty one
