Now all men by these presents that I Lucinda
Brant of the District and State aforesaid for

and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and Eighty five dollars
75 to me in hand paid by Olive Barrett hath bargain sold and released
and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto the said Olive
Barrett his heirs Executors administrators or assigns all my interest in
the tract of land belonging to the estate of W P Brant dec'd when I now
live adjoining lands of E. C Hawkins D. F. Patton W. W. Price
and others and I also sell and deliver unto the said Olive Barrett of the
State and District aforesaid the following articles of personal property
viz one grey mare, one Buggy and harness one red & white spider cow
one Birnie knife one spotted sow one silver watch one music box
one metal clock Two beds and furniture with all the furniture
increase of the Stock unto the said Olive Barrett his heirs Executors
administrators or assigns forever

Provided nevertheless and it is expressly agreed between
the said parties that if the said Lucinda Brant her Executors adm-
inistrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
Olive Barrett his certain attorney Executors administrators or assigns
the amount of a certain note given by said Lucinda Brant to the said
Olive Barrett administrator of the estate of W P Brant dec'd for one
hundred and Eighty five dollars 75 bearing date the 22nd of November
1855 payable at three months with interest from date payment to be
made or before the 22nd of February next then the above mortgage and
every article and thing therein contained shall cease and be utterly
void otherwise remain in full force and virtue

in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five
