resign To      58      For      Stone of the Hall of South Carolina Spartan  
fully Simon Stone      Land     burg District of the one part Catharine  
Stone of the other part Both of Spartanburg District South Carolina  
I set witnesseth for an consideration of the sum of Six Thousand Dollars  
in hand paid by the said Catharine Stone of the said Tilman Stone the  
sum aforesaid whereof doth acknowledge hath granted bargained sold and by  
these presents do grant Bargain and sell unto the said Stone a certain  
plantation or tract of Land lying and being in the said State and in Greenville  
for which on both sides Gap Creek waters of Saluda containing Two Thousand  
and fifty acres more or less Beginning on a Chestnut Hummock N 33° 6' 52" chains  
and due a meadow thence S 8° E 26 to a pine tree south 40° 34.58 across the Creek to  
thence North West South 49° W 72' to a Stake thence a crop the creek N 57° W 24'  
thence first Station to gather with all the woods waters & water courses thereof  
to command all that appertaining heretofore to whatsoever tenements belonging  
therein and to hold the said Tract of ~~Two hundred~~ and fifty six acres  
and all and singular the presence thereby unto the said Catharine Stone  
or heirs and assigns forever for ever and I the said Tilman Stone  
Warrant & forever defend the above said presences against my  
now myself my heirs and assigns seven persons or persons what so ever  
by the witness where at I the said Tilman Stone have her unto let  
mortgaged hand and affixed my seal this the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1836
