consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars in hand paid to the said John Wood the receipt is hereby acknowledged he has bargained sold and delivered and do by these presents bargain sell and deliver a certain tract of land containing two hundred and sixty acres more or less lying in the State and District aforesaid lying on the side of Fall Creek beginning Phillips conditional Line thence along Bams line to a hickory thence the same course to the N E line of said tract to a hickory made by parties thence S 10 W along said N E line reverse a to a white oak 37 thence S 3 E 41 chains or links to Phillips conditional line to have and to hold all and singular the woods waters and water courses profits and privileges hereditaments and appertinances of the said John Wood do warrant and for ever defend the rights and title of the above tract Land to said John Wood and his heirs for ever from any person or persons lawfully claiming the same in witness whereunto I set my hand and seal this 22nd day of January 1816 Signed in presence of us Just
