This Indenture made this third day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty four between Robert M. Kay Ordinary of the District aforesaid and Eli Carney of the same State and District. Whereas a writ of Summons to divide or sell a certain tract of Land hereinafter described of the Estate of Eli Alewine of said District deceased issued from the Court of Ordinary of said District and upon the return thereof the Judge of said Court did determine that the said Land could be divided with injury to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid on a credit of twelve months with interest from the day of sale.
