Towns the Trustee named in the deed described in the Petition be authorized to sell the Lands embraced in said deed at Greenville Court House on some sateday at Public auction after at least Twenty One days advertisement. and whereas in Pursuance of said order the said G. H. Towns did sell the said Land at public auction to Waddy Thompson Esqr for the sum of five hundred Dollars he being at that Price the highest and last bidder Now therefore know all men by these Present that in consideration of the premises and of the sum of five hundred Dollars by the said W. Thompson in hand Paid to the said George H. Towns of the said George H. Towns Trustee as aforesaid have given granted bargained sold & conveyed to the said Waddy Thompson his heirs

and assigns forever all that Tract or Parcel of Land situated Lying and being in the District and State aforesaid originally granted to Alexander West 1st Decr 1800 and by the said Alexander West conveyed to Thomas Edwards by deed bearing date 19. Sept 1801 by the said Thomas Edwards conveyed to Waddy Thompson and by the said Waddy Thompson to Dr. W. Brazier 4th day of March 1826 and by the said William Brazier to George H. Towns Trustee as aforesaid by deed bearing date 26th July 1842 containing three Hundred acres more or less and Lying On the South Side of Paris mountain described and laid down in the grant and Plat of the State to Alexander West also One other Tract of 300 acres adjoining the aforesaid Tract as described in the deed from West to Edwards and from Edwards to W.
