Whereas the Bearer hereof Cyrus is a man of colour heretofore the slave of my late husband Roger Loveland and since his death of this estate has since the death of my said husband caused to be paid to me the sum of four hundred dollars the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge as administrator of his estate and do for my self and my heirs and the heirs of said estate relinquish all claim title and interest or to the future service of the said negro man Cyrus from now forth to the end of his life as fully as if he had never been a slave. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Greenville Court House the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1858

aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars to me paid by my son Wm M Kinney have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto my son William M Kinney all that tract or parcel of Land purchased by my Father from Lee Hendricks and conveyed from him to my self being on Beatties Branch Devils Fork creek and both sides of the middle fork of Saluda River commencing near a small spring at the upper end of the lower plantation running thence N 45 E 3 chains to a stake on Wm Coxs line thence with the various courses of Cox's line till it strikes Delongs pine corner thence with Delongs line to a pine corner thence N 40 E 16 chains to a Spanish oak thence N 42 W 5 chains to stake corner on Nesbit Survey thence N 34 W a cross the Nesbit Survey to a dogwood corner on Brannon and Nesbit line thence N 32 E 10 chains to the corner of the old Brannon tract thence with the Brannon line to a white oak corner on the branch near Hugh Potts House thence S 58 E 7 chains to sweet gum thence N 70 E 3 chains to a stake thence a conditional between Hugh Potts and my self to the river thence up the River cross the river to David Baynes corner thence with Barnes line to a white oak on the east line of the Brannon Survey thence S 32 W 31 chains to a black oak Nesbits corner thence S 55 E 17 50 to W. oak thence S 32 W 20 73 gum thence S 58 E 20 chestnut oak thence S 45 W 45 chains to stake thence S 28 E 16 chestnut oak on M Jenkins thence South M Jenkins line to a conditional line between M Jenkins and my self dividing the Mayfield tract N 56 E with the Mayfield tract to a chestnut at the head of a branch thence down said branch to the beginning containing seven hundred acres more or less together with all the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William M Kinney his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and forever defend and singular the said premises unto the said Wm M Kinney his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and any person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same.
