All that tract piece parcel or lot of land situated and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid containing two acres more or less in the Village or town of Greenville. Beginning at a Stake 3+ near the Buncombe Road W. B Thompsons corner and running thence along or near said Road South 37° East 208 1/2 feet to a Stake 3+ thence South sixty three degrees West 417 feet to a Stake 3+ thence North 37° West 208 1/2 feet to a Stake 3+ on said W. B Thompsons line thence with said W. B Thompsons line to the beginning 217 feet. Together with all the rights Members and hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Spartin D Goodlett and Henry K Williams their heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend forever all and singular the said premises unto the said Spartin D Goodlett and Henry K Williams their heirs and assigns forever against my self my heirs executors and administrators and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim under me as trustee of Catharine S Mc Kay. Hundred Dollars to us paid by Charles H Lanman Jr of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charles H Lanman Jr all that piece parcel and lot of Land containing Two acres more or less situate lying and in the Town of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid and being the following lines metes and bounds viz Beginning at a Stake 3+ near the Buncombe Road C J Elford corner formerly W B Thompsons and running thence along or near said road South 37° East 208 1/2 feet to a Stake 3+ thence South 63° West 417 feet to a Stake 3+ thence North 37° West 208 1/2 feet to a Stake 3+ on said C J Elford line thence with said C J Elford line to the beginning 417 feet being the same lot of Land conveyed to us from Allen Macfarlan Trustee of Mrs Catharine S Mc Kay by deed of November 20th 1857.
