Land granted to James Brown the sixth day of August
Eighteen hundred and Twenty One having the following cour-
ses and lines beginning on a Lowerwood on brushy creek 3/4
running N 30 E. to a post oak 3/4 thence N 60 E 2/3 to a birch
on Enoree river thence Down the meanders of said river
to white it intersects with Brushy Creek thence up the
various meanderings of said Creek to near the Spring thence
round said Spring including One acre & said Spring on the
south side of said Creek thence back to the Creek. thence up its
meanders to the beginning corner bounded by Lands of William Smith
