Know all Men by these presents, that J. Henry E Lynch of the State and District aforesaid do by this instrument of writing or declaration of trust, in consideration of Natural love and affection, and in the further consideration of Ten dollars to me in part paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, testify, acknowledge, make known, and declare that I hold the following Property (in addition to that mentioned) and contained in a former declaration of Trust, bearing date the 4th day of January 1858. One Negro Man, named Oliver, about twenty one years of age, Two Bureaus, One Carpet, one Clock, Five Tables, one set of each Table and Desert Knife, & forks, one dozen Wares

spoons, one set Castors, also three Cows and Calves, one mare Colt one sow Pigs, with their increase. In Trust to, and for the sole and separate and exclusive use of my Daughter Eliza Jane Crittenden, Wife of J. Stanley Crittenden, also of the District and State aforesaid, during the life of my said Daughter, free from the Debts, Contract, or liabilities of her present or any former husband, and at the death of my said Daughter, to go to her children share and share alike, the issue of a deceased child to represent the Parent and in case of her dying without children, then to her lawful Heirs and the said Property is held by me in Trust as aforesaid, free from all liability on account of, any individual debts, Contract, or agreements.
