I Jesse D Green for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Pleasant G Green, have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Pleasant G Green all that tract or parcel of land situate in the District & State aforesaid on branches of Buckhorn creek waters of Enoree river containing ninety acres be the same more or less the same being part of a tract of land sold by the Sheriff to W A Cauble & by Cauble to J B Roseman & by Roseman to Henry McAuley & by McAuley to my self Beginning on a Rock on Curtis Bradley corner thence S 33 67/4 37 chs to S. O.
