 the said Samuel Mc Green, all that piece parcel and tract of land  
 containing One hundred and thirty six and one half (136 1/2) acres more  
 or less situated lying and being in the District of Greenville in the

State aforesaid upon the waters of Richland Creek of Keedy River  
 and upon the North west side of the Spartanburg road and about  
 two miles from Greenville Court House and adjoining lands of Irvine  
 Stone & Thompson et al and having the following lines, metes and bounds  
 that is to say beginning at a stake in Spartanburg road (Irvine corner  
 and running thence N 38 1/4 W 17.76 to a white oak &c &c thence N 53 W 9  
 to a stone &c &c thence S 81 W 32.97 to a stone &c thence S 45 1/4 E 9.44 to
