

Trustee shall have full power and authority to sell and dispose of the said female slave Margaret and her future increase after legally advertising them upon such terms as he may deem most expedient and the proceeds arising from the sale of the said trust property to be divided as follows one third part thereof to be paid to her husband if living and the remaining two thirds to her children should she have no child or children then the two thirds to go to my estate to be disposed of agreeable to the laws of distribution or as I may direct by will.
