

William Choice  
 To Samuel W White  
 Deed For Land State of South Carolina  
 This indenture made the seventh day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between William Choice Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville C.S. in the said State of the one part and Samuel W White of Greenville District of the other part, Menas Andrew Johnson and Eliza his wife late Eliza Crymes in their own right and as Guardians on or about the twenty fifth day of June 1827 did exhibit their bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Samuel W White and Nancy E White his wife late Nancy E Crymes and Thomas Crymes Administrators and Guardians stating that William M Crymes deceased seized and possessed of a valuable real estate leaving the said Nancy E his widow John D George W Marthe v Mary A Thomas P and William M Crymes and the wife of the said Andrew Johnson his heirs at Law him surviving and prayed for partition of the said real estate according to their rights, and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at Last July Term, when the said Court after full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, did order adjudge and decree that the said real estate of the said William M Crymes deceased should be sold at public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the Decretal order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear, and the said William Choice as Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said Lands for sale by public outcry, on the seventh day of December first above mentioned did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said Tract of Land below described, unto the said Samuel W White for the sum of eighteen hundred and one dollar he being at that price, the highest bidder for the same. Now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said William Choice as Commissioner of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of eighteen hundred and one dollar paid him by the said Samuel W White the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel W White his heirs and assigns all that tract of land situate in Greenville District containing two hundred and fifty nine acres more or less beginning at a Hickory on the road & running N 51 E 17.50 to a gum thence N 30 W 24.50 to R.O. then S 76 W 16.50 to R.O. on the road then with the road to a P O then N 41 W 25.50 to a R.O. then S 30 W 25.75 to a R.O. thence S 66 E 19.75 to a stake at the corner of Lot No 2 and thence S 66 E a straight line to the beginning corner including the dwelling house of the said William M Crymes deceased, together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and remainders unto issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate right title interest dower possession property benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at Law

and in Equity of the heirs and representatives of the said William M Crymes deceased, and of all the parties to this suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof by from or under them or either of them, to have and to hold the said Tract of Land with its hereditaments privileges and appurtenances unto the said Samuel W White (his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof, for ever

 Deed For Land The State of South Carolina Greenville District  
 Whereas we the undersigned heirs at Law of James Wood, deceased, are of opinion that it was the intention of the said deceased, in his lifetime to give to his nephew William Bull part of the tract of land & plantation whom the said W Bull now lives which the intestate purchased from William E Wickliff therefore to carry into effect the intention of said deceased as well as in consideration of one dollar to us in hand paid have sold & released & by these presents do give sell & release unto the said W Bull all that upper end of the said tract of land beginning on a Hickory corner of Jones land thence N 55 W 73 to a R.O. thence N 41 E 3 to a pine thence N 82 E 30 to R.O. thence S 66 E to a conditional corner near the head of the second small branch which the line crosses, thence to the beginning, supposed to contain One hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have & to hold all and singular the said premises to the said W Bull his heirs and assigns forever & we do hereby bind ourselves to warrant & defend all & singular the said premises to the said W Bull from us & our heirs forever In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals this 31st day of August 1848 signed sealed in presence of James Darby S Goodlett
