Shockey of the State and District aforesaid have bargained sold and released and do by these presents bargain sell and release unto the aforesaid Thomas J. Shockey a certain tract or parcel of land whereon the now lives lying on the South side of Rocky Creek containing Eighty Acres more or less in the State and District aforesaid on a white oak corner on the South side of the aforesaid creek thence S 4 3/4 E seven chains and fifty links to a stake corner thence S 3 1/4 E fourteen chains and fifty four links to a black jack corner thence N 31 E four chains and seventy five links to a pine corner thence S 25 E Twelve chains and fifty links to a stake corner on Burrell Hudson Spring Branch thence down the meanders of said Branch to a chestnut corner now down thence N 10 W six teen chains and thirty seven links to a sweet gum on the north side of the aforesaid Rocky Creek thence up the meanders of the Creek to the beginning white oak corner.
