in consideration of the sum of four hundred and
fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by John A. Smith
of Greenville District and State aforesaid have
granted, bargained, sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said John A. Smith all that that Tract or parcel
of Land situate lying and being in Greenville
District and State aforesaid on the South side
of Rocky Creek of Enoree River, it being part of
a Tract of Land originally granted to Reuben Smith
A. D. 1786. Beginning at a Birch st on the bank of
Rocky Creek near the Ford of the road leading
to Baylis Smiths and runs thence with said Road due
South 31.80 to a Stake st in the road on the original
line thence with said line N 58 3/4 W. 24.30 to a
birch st on the Bank of Little Rocky Creek. Thence
down said Creek with the meanders to where
it empties into Rocky Creek. Thence down said

Creek with a short ditch and meanders of the old
channel to the beginning containing forty five and
one half acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the Right to membership
Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the said
Premises unto the said John A. Smith His Heirs &
assigns forever. and I do hereby bind my self, my
Heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said
Premises unto the said John A. Smith His Heirs and
assigns against me and my Heirs and against
every other person or persons Lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof. Except that
I still hold the right of cutting or using any
timber on the said Premises. During my life, also
in making this conveyance I do not convey to
the said John A. Smith the right to sell or convey
the said Tract of Land to any other person
