and for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars  
to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said W<sup>th</sup> B<sup>th</sup> Glenn  
the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have  
granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant  
bargain and sell unto the said W<sup>th</sup> B<sup>th</sup> Glenn his heirs and  
assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with  
its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which  
the said Beverly B<sup>th</sup> Garrett of right had of in and to the same  
to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land  
with its appurtenances unto the said W<sup>th</sup> B<sup>th</sup> Glenn his heirs and  
assigns forever as fully and absolutely as the said I Hooke might  
could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the  
Statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Fine & Fees or otherwise  
I do witness whereof I the said I Hooke Sheriff have hereunto set my hand  
and seal the second day of November in the year of our Lord
