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District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of  
the sum of seven thousand and fifty dollars in hand paid  
by Alberty Ballenger of Greenville District and State aforesaid  
have granted bargained sold and released and by these pres-  
ents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alberty  
Ballenger two tracts or parcels of Land situated lying and  
being in Greenville District and State aforesaid on the  
North Side of Middle Syger River bounded as follows viz  
Beginning at Joseph McKinneys Rock corner in the Middle  
of Syger River thence with McKinneys line to a pine thence to  
a chestnut thence to a Rock thence along the old line to a post oak  
thence to a Rock corner the dividing line to a pine thence with  
Joseph McKinneys to a rock thence to a rock thence to a chestnut  
thence to a double mulberry thence to a persimmon thence down  
the branch to the mouth of the branch thence down the river  
to the beginning corner containing by Estimation fifty four &  
half acres be the same more or less. Together with all and  
singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in anywise Incident or apper-  
taining. To hold all and singular the premises before men toward

unto the said Alberty Ballenger His heirs and assigns forever  
and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administra-  
tors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
premises unto the said Alberty Ballenger his heirs and assigns  
for ever against me and my heirs and against every other person  
or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part

One thousand Eight hundred and fifty nine in the Eighty  
fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America
