I hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and by
these presents do bargain sell convey & release unto the said
Archibald Ramsey his heirs & assigns all that piece parcel
or tract of Land on which he now lives lying being & situate
in the State & District above named and bounded on the East
by the Lands of Dr J Sullivan & Robert Bolling & on the North
and west by Squ Calhoun now Andrew Ramseys Land
originally belonging to Hudson Berry Esqr and sold by him to
Serry & Bolling of said place & deeded to said S. T. Bolling by
Micajah Berry Esqr son heir and Executor of said Hudson
Berry deceased. Sold deeded & conveyed by the sd Serry &
Bolling to the said Samuel Ramsey the grantor of these
rights, the above bargained premises are these described
Beginning on a Stake & Stone 3+ near the road at Robert
