 To Gower Cox & Markley Lot For The State of South Carolina
 Know all men by these presents
 that the Greenville and Columbia
 Rail Road Company a body corporate of the State aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and
 fifty Dollars to them paid by Ebenezer N Gower Thomas
 Gower Thomas M Cox and Henry C Markley partners com-
 posing the firm of Gower Cox & Markley of Greenville District in
 the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold unto the
 said Gower Cox & Markley all that piece parcel and Lot of
 Land containing about seven tenths of an acre situate lying
 and being in the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville S.C.
 and near the Depot of the said Company being laid down as
 Lot No 1 of the said Company Lots at Greenville S.C. in a plan
 of the same drawn by C Bringer March 1854 beginning at a stake
 on Wardry Street and running thence with said Street N 71 1/2
 W three hundred and two feet to a stake thence with a 30 feet

lane or street two hundred and seventy one feet to a stake
 thence with a 48 feet street one hundred and eighty five
 feet to a stake thence with Gower Cox & Markley's land
 thirty seven feet and six inches to the beginning corner together
 with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
 incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Gower
 Cox & Markley their heirs and assigns forever and the said
 the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company do hereby
 bind themselves and their successors to warrant and forever
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
