 was conveyed by the Commissioner of the said Court to  
 the heirs of the said Isaac West deceased containing  
 Twenty acres and so laid off as to include Ten acres  
 on the each side of Reedy river and Ten acres on  
 the other side of Reedy River and to include the shoal  
 and water privileges when James West once had a  
 mill adjoining lands of P. Huff P. H. West and J. R. Snyper  
 and others. Together with all and singular the rights  
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in anywise incident or  
 appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular  
 the premises before mentioned unto the said William J
