

I D. Guin Deed State of South Carolina  
 To of Greenville District  
 N A Heaster Trust Know all men by these presents

that I the Decatur Guin of Greenville District State of S. C. for and in consideration of the natural love and affection I bear to my beloved wife Laura M. Guin and of the fact that the Negro being after mentioned was given to me by her Father Samuel G. McClanahan Esqr and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid to me by Nathan A. Heaster of Greenville District S. C. have given aliened and released unto the said N A Heaster my right title and interest in and to a certain Negro Slave Girl named Emma about seventeen years old and her child named Sinus about one year old to have and to hold the said Emma & Sinus and his Increase to him the said N A Heaster and his successors in the trust hereafter mentioned against me and my heirs and every one lawfully claiming under me forever. Now the Express understanding of the above gift is the following. To wit that the said Negro Slave Emma & Sinus shall be held by the said N A Heaster for the special use and benefit of my wife Laura M. Guin free and independent of all my future debts liabilities and contracts or of all debts liabilities and contracts of any future husband she may hereafter have. Secondly that the said N A Heaster may Dispose of or change the investment of the value in said Negroes Emma and her child Sinus their increase or any part of the said increase in any way which he may deem proper upon written application to him from her instruction from me. Thirdly that the said N A Heaster by and with the written consent or request of my said wife may change the trusteeship in the said Negroes Emma and Sinus and her future increase at any time they may deem proper by endorsement on this paper. Fourthly that should the said N A Heaster die without appointing a successor in this trust then my said wife may in the foregoing manner appoint one herself. Independent of further instructions from me. And Fifthly that my said wife in anticipation of her death may dispose of the said Negro Slaves Emma and Sinus and her future increase or the then corpus of the trust Estate in whatever shape it may be by will and testament in any manner she may deem proper as if she were a feme sole in law.

Given under my hand and seal on this the fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty and in the Eighty fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America.

 Thadens M Templeton Trust Greenville District

Know all men by these presents that I Elizabeth R Peden for & in consideration of the natural love & affection which I have & bear towards my daughter Martha Caroline Templeton & for & in consideration of Five dollars to me in hand paid by Thadens M Duffie Templeton husband of the said Martha Caroline have bargained & sold given & conveyed and by these presents do bargain & sell give & convey unto the said Thadens M Duffie Templeton a negro girl named Edeline about ten years old in trust for my said daughter Martha Caroline Templeton to have & to hold the said negro girl Edeline & her increase in trust for the sole & separate use of my said daughter Martha Caroline Templeton during her life & at her death to divide the said negro girl Edeline & all her increase & issue equally amongst the children of my said daughter Martha Caroline Templeton & the issue of such child or children as may have died according to the Statutes of Distribution in South Carolina & their heirs forever and in case my said daughter Martha Caroline Templeton should die without issue of her body living at her death then & in that case the said negro girl Edeline & all her increase & issue to be the absolute right & property of my said son in law Thadens M Duffie Templeton & his heirs forever.
