I Eleanor Shelton of the State and District aforesaid for the consideration of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by Marshall Shelton of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained and by these presents do grant bargained and sell unto the said Marshall Shelton and his heirs one tract of land containing ninety two acres of land be the same more or less bounded as follows viz beginning at a chestnut

corner on top of a ridge on an old road known as mountain path Mc Sheltons and C Sheltons corner on S Mc A Turpins line with S Turpins line to a white oak corner dead & down at present a sweet gum on a branch the waters of Orono River thence crossing S branch seven rods to a stake corner by pine bush in old field S Turpins corner on Richard Goodletts line thence with S Goodletts line thirty four rods to a stake corner on S Goodletts and R J Richards line thence through an old field with S Richards line to a Chestnut corner on S Richards Spring branch made by H Shelton & S Richards thence down S branch nine rods and four foot to a sweet gum dead at the fork of S branch widow Newby and Sheltons corner thence crossing a branch with S Newbys line to a sweet gum corner dead on a small branch known as mountain spring branch thence up S branch to the head cornering on a dogwood S Newby & Sheltons corner thence to a chestnut corner by mountain oak stump on an old road known as mountain path S Newby corner thence with S road to a post oak sapling thence with S road to a mountain oak corner S Newbys line thence a straight line to a black locust Mc Shelton and S Newbys corner thence a straight line to the beginning.
