 skill and integrity full power is hereby given to you to take
 the renunciation of Francis Morris wife of Joel E. Morris
 of Cobb County in the State of Georgia her Dower in the premises
 described in the foregoing deed which conveys a certain
 interest in land therein described from the said Joel E. Morris
 to G. N. Green and Willis M. Green for this purpose you will
 cause the said Francis Morris to appear before you and you
 will examine her privately and separately apart from all
 other persons and if upon such examination she shall
 freely declare that she does freely voluntarily and without
 any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons
 whomsoever renounce release and forever relinquish
 to G. N. Green and Willis M. Green their heirs and assigns
 her interest and estate and also all right and claim
 of Dower of in and to all and singular the premises
 described and conveyed in the Deed aforesaid, then you
 shall take under her hand a certificate of her renuncia-
 tion as aforesaid which certificate authenticated by your
 hands and seals you shall annex to this writ, Full power
 is also hereby given to you to take probate of the execution of
 the aforesaid Deed and for this purpose you shall cause
 one of the subscribing witnesses of the Deed aforesaid to
 appear before you and having administered to him, as
 you are hereby fully authorized to do, an oath or
 solemn affirmation according to the form of his religious
 persuasion that his affidavit is true, you shall take
 under his hand an affidavit that he was personally
 present and saw Joel E. Morris sign seal and deliver
 the Deed aforesaid for the uses and intents therein exp-
 ressed and that the other subscribing witness signed their
 names thereto as witnesses of its due execution which
 affidavit authenticated under your hands and seals
 you shall annex to this writ, and having certified
 under your hands and seals the due execution of
 this writ and verified the same by the oath of one of
 you before some Magistrate who is authorized by the
 Laws of your State to administer an oath and whose
 official signature may be properly authenticated you
 shall carefully return this writ, together with your
 proceedings therein to the Clerk of the Court of Common
 Pleas and General Sessions for Greenville District
 and State of South Carolina to be duly recorded
