 granted bargained sold and released, and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said Newton Babb all that tract of land known
 as the part Peden Tract containing 136, One hundred
 and thirty six acres situated in the District aforesaid
 beginning on a White oak thence S 64 1/8 N 79.50 thence S 25 W
 5 S 6 1/4 W 14 bounded by R Brysons White oak stump thence S 67
 E 44 to Pine bounded by Thomas Goldsmith thence N 40 1/2 E 11 50 to
 State N 75 E to a State thence N 4 W 4 thence S 50 E to State
 thence N 12 1/2 E 10.16 to State bounded by J S Thomason thence N 64
 W 54.50 the beginning bounded by John Gault

Together with all and singular the rights members
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To
 have and to hold all and singular the premises before

 assigns forever and we do hereby bind our heirs execu-

 defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 said Newton Babb his heirs and assigns against
 us and our heirs and against every other person law-
 fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
