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that I John Nash of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to me paid by Edward Nash Jun of the said State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and release and by these presents do grant bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Edward Nash Jun a plantation and tract of Land lying in the State and District aforesaid on the South fork of Rabunus Creek waters of Ruddy River it being part of a tract of Land originally granted to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Robert McOwen to wit the seventh of July One thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight and containing Two Hundred and fifty three acres, all that part of said Tract of Land lying on the North East side of said Creek and beginning on the original line at the Creek and running on said line N 33 E to a black oak 3x thence N 40 W to a pine 3x then 50 W to said creek then down said Creek to the Beginning Except a bout one acre more or less on the said Creek so as to include the mill seat with the saw and Grist Mill that now belongs to Edward Nash Senr, Beginning on a Sassafras 3x near the mill dam running East a bout 30 yards to a Stake 3x then running South about 20 yards to a black oak 3x then running as the course a crop said Creek to a post oak 3x then up said Creek to the Beginning corner, which acre of Land with the seat and Mill &c is Expressly understood and agreed upon between the parties that it is Excepted out of the the premises here conveyed from the said John Nash to the said Edward Nash and containing One Hundred and twenty seven acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Edward Nash Senr his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises Except as above Excepted, unto the said Edward Nash Senr his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs
