 hath granted bargained sold and released and by  
 these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
 unto the said B S Brockman a certain tract or  
 parcel of land lying and being in Greenville  
 District and in the State aforesaid on the waters  
 of Enoree River Beginning at white oak corner on  
 the branch on Clark line hence up said branch to  
 a Stake on Spartanburg road hence along said  
 west to a rock on the west corner of Cooper fence hence  
 along said fence to Holly on Bishops line hence along  
 said line to a rock corner in the old field or a Hickamore  
 in said Old road hence along said road to the beginning  
 corner on the branch. Together with all and singular  
 the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
 to the said premises belonging or in anywise incid-  
 ent or appertaining. To have and to hold all and  
 singular the premises aforesaid unto the said B S  
 Brockman his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby  
 bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to  
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the above  
 said premises unto the said B S Brockman his heirs and  
 assigns against me and my heirs Executors and against  
 every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming  
 or to claim the same or any part thereof.
