 presents that I Reuben

Garrison of the State and District aforesaid for
 the incconsideration of two hundred Dollars to me paid
 in hand by William Garrison of the State and District above
 mentioned and Conveyed unto the said William
 Garrison a tract or parcel of land containing One
 hundred and thirteen acres be the same more or
 less on the waters of Packer's Creek a stream of
 South by ger Bounded as follows Beginning on a
 chestnut oak \$ 86 00 57.50 to a Ash thence No 12 $\frac{1}{3}$ 00 12
 14 to Post oak thence No 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ 00 27.50 to a ash thence
 up the my andes of said Branch to a slate thence
 \$ 0 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ 00 14.60 to a slate thence \$ 0 29 $\frac{1}{3}$ 00 19. to a chestnut oak
 the beginning corner on the top of Packer's mountain
 Together with all and singular the rights members
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold
 all and Singular the premises before mentioned to the
 said William Garrison his heirs an assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and
 admr to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said William Garrison his
 heirs assigns against my self and my heirs and against
 all and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming
 or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness
 whereof I the said Reuben Garrison have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal this 7th of January One
 Thousand and Eight Hundred and fifty four. Signed sealed
