 Know all men by these presents that for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Seven  $75/100$  Dollars to me in hand paid by John H Walker I do hereby grant bargain sell and release unto the said John H Walker all my Interest in the Estate of my Father Lynn Walker deceased as left me in his will which is Three Hundred Dollars and Equal Share with the rest of the Children if any left paying me the Three Hundred Dollars above mentioned I do hereby sell the same to the said John H Walker for the above named price I also warrant and defend the same unto the said John H Walker against my self my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns unto himself his heirs Exors adms and assigns forever I do hereby appoint the said John H Walker my lawful attorney to collect all the money due me from my father's estate and receipt for the same due and collect in my name but for his own use & benefit, and In fact to have full power to do in and about the premises.
