This indenture made and entered into the seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one between Alexander P. Leroy and his wife Lucinda F. Leroy, formerly Lucinda F. Wells, of the one part and William H. Ashmon of the other part. Witnesseth whereas the said Lucinda F. Leroy did in the Court of Equity for said District at July Term of the present year obtain a decree in her own right for the sum of fourteen hundred and fifty six dollars and twenty five cents to be paid to her by the administrator of Carter Wells deceased and whereas the amount of the said decree together with interest thereon being fourteen hundred and eighty one dollars and fifteen cents has been paid into the hands of John J. McDaniel Sheriff of said District under a Writ of fieri facias by W. M. Thomas Esqr administrator of the Estate of Carter Wells deceased and hath not in anywise come into the possession or control of the said Alexander P. Leroy and whereas the said sum of money so in the hands of the said Sheriff is subject to the payment of the fees of the solicitors in Equity of said Lucinda F. Leroy for their services in obtaining said decree which fees amount to four hundred dollars, and which will leave the sum of one thousand and eighty one dollars and fifteen cents to be released by the said Lucinda F. Leroy, and whereas it is desirable and hath been agreed by and between the said parties that the said amount, so to be released by the said Mrs. Lucinda F. Leroy shall be settled and secured to her separate and exclusive use and benefit upon the terms trusts and condition hereinafter set forth
