Whereas Samuel Payne Executor and John McGrady and R P Goodlett known trading and dealing as Grady & Goodlett. on or about the twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight exhibited their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against John Griffith et al for the sale of a certain tract of land.
