Know all men by these presents that I James W Mitchell of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by J of Mitchell of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said J of Mitchell apart of a tract of land lying in Greenville District on the head waters of McCools Beaver dam creek waters of Middle Tyger river Beginning on a chestnut thence S 58 1/2 E 50 to a stake thence 2 ch to a chestnut, thence N 9 ch to a pine, thence to a white oak near the spring thence to a stake on the Jordan road thence up the road to a stake thence to the branch on a stake thence S 35 W 30 ch to the beginning chestnut corner containing one hundred and ten acres more or less being apart of a tract of land granted to James Clark bearing date 1796. Together with all things appertaining to the above premises unto the said J of Mitchell his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heir executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J of Mitchell his heirs and assigns and against my self my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Mitchell of the District and State aforesaid for an inconsideration of the natural love and affection which I have for my son Thomas J Mitchell and my daughter Anah Mitchell and also inconsideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Thomas J Mitchell I have given granted bargained sold and released and conveyed unto the said Thomas J Mitchell and Anah Mitchell my daughter during her single life and at her marriage or death the premises belongs to the said Thomas J
