 whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted and released
 and conveyed unto the said Amelia Hoyt all my right title and
 interest in and to a certain Mulatto woman named Hagar Ann
 Together with her former children, Viz, Wells John Jane and Sarah
 with all such other issue as may arise from said Hagar Ann
 or any of her female children during the natural life of my said
 wife Amelia Hoyt, To have and to hold the above described negro
 woman and her children and their issue unto her the said Amelia
 Hoyt for her sole and exclusive use and behoof during her natural
 life to be by her disposed of by will or deed as best suits her desires
 and I the said J C Hoyt do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns
 forever to warrant and defend the above described negro servants unto
 her the said Amelia Hoyt her heirs and assigns against myself my heirs
 and assigns and also against any and every other person or persons
 lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixteenth day of June in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty, signed sealed & delivred
 in presence of P McGovern
