Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William McKinny sen his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William McKinny sen his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
