Know all men by these presents that I Reubin Tally of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One thousand and ninety eight dollars to me paid by William McKinney of Greenville District in the State aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William McKinney (a tract of land containing by estimation three thousand and twenty three acres more or less being a part of a tract of land granted Nathaniel Perry by a grant bearing date the fourth day of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty five and part of a <sup>part</sup> tract of land granted to Robert Prince by a grant bearing date the tenth day of November one thousand seven hundred and eighty six, also part of a tract of land conveyed to me from the State of South Carolina by the Superintendent of Public works situate in the State of South Carolina Greenville District and part of the above named tract was conveyed to me by William Choice of Greenville District South Carolina situate and being on the branches of Morris fork of Enore River, and runs as follows viz, Beginning on a Post oak on the South west of Perrys Survey thence due east twenty five chains and seventy five links to a Red oak, thence N 12 E to a Post oak thence a straight line crossing William S Carters Spring branch to a red oak near the Ashville road thence N 34 1/4 E to a Stone thence bounded South
