 the Said, The Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Com-
 -pany do hereby bind themselves and their successors
 to warrant and forever defend all and Singular the
 Said premises unto the Said Moses W Haiger his heirs
 and assigns against the Said, The Greenville and
 Columbia Rail Road Company their successors and
 assigns, and against every other person whomsoever lawf-
 ully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
