

Robt McKay 09.4 Decd. State of South Carolina
 So For Greenville District
 G W French Land This Indenture made the Seventh
 day of April in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty two between
 Robert McKay ordinary of the District aforesaid, and George
 W French of the same State and District, Whereas a writ
 of summons to divide or sell a certain tract of Land
 hereinafter described of the Estate of Rebecca Stone of said
 District, deceased, issued from the Court of Ordinary of
 said District, and upon the return thereof, the Judge of
 said Court did determine that the said Land could not
 be divided without injury to the parties interested, and
 did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid, on a credit of twelve months, with interest from the day
 of sale, Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said
 Land for sale on the first Monday in April in the year above
 mentioned, and whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said
 day expose to sale at public outcry, on the credit aforesaid the said
 Land when the said George W French was the last and highest
 bidder, to whom the said Land was struck off for the sum of Five
 Hundred and Five Dollars, Now this Indenture witnesseth
 that in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and five dollars
 to me paid and secured to be paid I have granted bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said George W French and his heirs
 and assigns forever, all that Tract of Land situated in said
 District on waters of Mountain Creek and Saluda River
 adjoining lands of Ellison G W French John Cooley and others
 and containing One Hundred Acres more or less
 together with all the appurtenances therunto belonging
 and all the estate right title interest claim or demand which
 the said Rebecca Stone deceased, at the time of her death
 had in or to the same, To have and to hold the said Tract of
 Land together with all and singular the premises improprietments
 and appurtenances to the said George W French
 his heirs and assigns forever
 In witness whereof I the said Robert McKay as ordinary aforesaid have
 hereunto set my hand and seal of office the day and year above written
 Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of 3 Robt McKay Seal
 of W of West Jesse French 3 O. G. 4
