Know all men by these presents  
that I At f Ponder of Greenville

District in the aforesaid State in consideration of Fifteen Thousand  
red dollars to me paid by L D McMakin of Greenville District  
in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and  
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
unto the said L D McMakin all that tract or parcel of Land  
situate lying and being in Greenville District and State  
aforesaid on both sides of Beaver dam Creek waters of Middle  
Tyger River and bounded as follows beginning at a stone S 82 W  
40 to a hickory thence N 52 W 32.50 to a stone thence south  
to a stake thence N 76 E to a Chestnut, thence along an old  
craft fence or hedge row to a stake, thence S 62 E 26.50 to a stake  
thence N 32 E 25. to a stone thence N 20 to the beginning containing  
One hundred and Eighty two acres be the same more or less  
Together with all and singular the rights members heredita-  
taments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
L D McMakin his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby  
bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said L D McMakin his heirs and assigns against me  
and my heirs and against every other person or persons  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
