 This indenture made the thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two
 between William M Thomas Esquire Commissioner of the honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the Said State of the one part and James H Ashmore of the other part Whereas James H Ashmore on or about the twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two exhibited his bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the Said State against Eleander Neunon et al for the partition of certain lands to which said Eleander Neunon and others filed answers consenting to said partition and the bill being taken proconfesso as to the other defendants and the cause being at issue before the honorable Court came on to be heard at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand and eight hundred and sixty two when the Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the said land should be partitioned according to the return of the commissioners in partition and the Survey thereof as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear, and the said William M Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court in accordance with said order makes this title. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said William M Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of three dollars paid him by the said James H Ashmore the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold
