 the said Slaves and their increase are to be kept and employed  
 for the sole use and benefit of my said daughter Harriet  
 N Gilbreath free from the debts and contracts of any husband  
 she may have during her natural life and at her death, said  
 Slaves and their increase are to be equally divided among  
 the issue of my said daughter living at her death and if my  
 said daughter Harriet N Gilbreath should die without leaving  
 issue living at her death then in that event she is hereby fully  
 empowered to dispose of said Slaves and their increase by her  
 will and Testament, and I do hereby warrant the title of  
 said Slaves unto the said John No Gilbreath Trustee as aforesaid  
 against myself and my heirs and against every other person lawfully  
 claiming them or any portion of them  
 As witness my hand and Seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1862
