 and fifty cents to me in hand paid by Charles S Hammond
 of Greenville District and State aforesaid have granted bar-
 gained sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said Charles S Hammond
 all that tract or lot of land situate lying and being in
 Greenville District and State aforesaid on branch waters of
 Needy River it being part of a Lot of Land that I purchased
 from the Estate of John S. Coleman beginning at a Stone 3+ near
 a branch and running thence S 9 1/2 E 22.64 to a Stone 3+ thence
 N 62 E 9.18 to a Stone 3+ thence N 28 3/4 W 19.45 to a Stone 3+ thence
 S 61 1/4 W 20.88 to the beginning containing twenty nine and one
 fourth acres more or less and hath such marks and forms as
 a Plat of the same hereunto annexed will more fully represent
 Together with all and singular the rights members here-
 ditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said Charles S Hammond his heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and admin-
 istrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said Charles S Hammond
 his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs
 and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming
 or to claim the same or any part thereof.
