

Vardry McBee Deed State of South Carolina
 To Greenville District
 Me A. Carson of Gift Be it Known that I Vardry
 McBee of the State and District
 aforesaid for and in consideration of the natural love and
 affection which I have and bear towards my daughter Mrs
 Martha A Carson widow of Leuch & Carson dec'd, of the
 same State and District and also in consideration of
 the sum of Five Dollars to me paid by the said Martha A
 Carson have this day given bargained and sold and do
 by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Martha
 A Carson the following slaves. To wit, Allen a man about
 40 years of age Affy an old woman Emilie a woman
 about 20 years old and her child Nathan about 20
 months old and Becca a yellow girl about 10 years
 old. The right and title to which said slaves I hereby
 warrant to the said Martha A Carson her heirs and
 assigns forever. Witness my hand & seal this Eleventh
 day of February 1863 In presence of
 D. Cooke H. F. Beattie Vardry McBee Seal

South Carolina} Appeared before me D Cooke and made
 Greenville District } oath that he saw Vardry McBee sign
 seal and deliver the within deed for the uses and purposes
 therein mentioned and that H F Beattie together with himself
 witnessed the due execution thereof

 know all men by these presents
 that I John Markley of Greenville

District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the
 sum of Two Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars to me paid by
 William Mc Jennings of Greenville District in the State aforesaid
 have granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 William Mc Jennings all those two pieces parcels and lots
 of land situate lying and being in the said District and State
 in the Town of Greenville on the East side of Main Street having
 the following lines metes and bounds, to wit. Lot No 1 Beginning
 at the corner of Main Street & an ally thence along Main Street
 116 W about one hundred feet to a corner of a piece of land sold
 Peter Canble whence from said corner S 74 E One hundred and
 seventy six feet to a Stake thence N 76 E to a line with said ally
 thence along that line to Main Street the beginning corner being
 the same lot of land conveyed to me by Jesse Dean by deed of
 October 28th AD 1838 Lot No 2 beginning at a Stake Peter
 Canbles corner and running thence North 68 E east one
