for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to me paid by Julia Ann Waldrop Eliza Waldrop and Nancy Waldrop of Greenville District in the State aforesaid and also for the love and affection which I bear to them as my sisters have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Julia Ann Waldrop Eliza Waldrop and Nancy Waldrop all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville District of this State on the Gap Creek Road adjoining lands of Cleveland Bates and others containing Two Hundred and ten acres more or less and more particularly described in a deed of conveyance from William M Thomas Commissioner in Equity for Greenville District in this State to me the aforesaid Joseph Waldrop bearing date the 2^d day of April A.D. 1863 and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Measur Conveyance for Greenville District together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Julia Ann Waldrop Eliza Waldrop and Nancy Waldrop and their heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Julia Ann Waldrop Eliza Waldrop and Nancy Waldrop and their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and any else lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this seventeenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three and in the Eighty seventh year of the sovereignty and independence of the State of South Carolina signed sealed and delivered in the presence
