 to pay William Bayne Two Hundred and Eighty four
 Dollars for value received interest to be paid annually
 the said principal and the interest thereon may be
 paid at any time within the said three years if William
 Bayne and Saxon both consent to it as witness my
 hand and seal 18th June 1863
