J L Barnwell	Deed	The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James L Barnwell of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two thousand Dollars that is to say the amount which I agreed to pay for the land to me paid by William H Campbell of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William H Campbell all that tract or parcel of land situate & being in the District of Greenville & State aforesaid on the White Horse road & Brushy Creek about three miles from the town of Greenville bounded by lands of the Estate of John A Lowner & lands lately belonging to Smith Davis V McBea & by J Willerman & others being the same tract purchased by the said Jas L Barnwell of the said W H Campbell & by said W H Campbell of F F Beattie beginning at a Hickory now State 34 on the white horse road & A Lowner corner, & running thence along said road S 36 1/2 E 14.50 to a Stake 34 on said road thence S 68 E 2 chs to a Post oak 34 34 thence N 53 E 39 chs to Brushy Creek on the Greenville & Columbia Rail Road when it crosses said Creek to a poplar 34 0 m thence S 58 W 33 to the beginning corner containing fifty two
